### RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators or any other person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The committee recommend that all riders have adequate personal, Third Party liability and horse insurance.
2. Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not MUST wear protective headgear that includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and fastened at all times. A riding hat complying BSEN 1384 is the compulsory minimum required. However, British Riding Clubs recommend that the PAS015 standard or equivalent be worn. MRC recommends that a body protector meeting the latest standards be worn in jumping classes and that medical armbands are worn.
3. Medical assistance will be provided by 999 call and a First Aider will be in attendance.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn and horses should be correctly turned out.
5. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the event or any of the published information.
6. In the event of an objection the secretary's decision is final.
7. No refund of entry fees will be made except on receipt of a doctor's or veterinary surgeon's certificate.
8. No horse or pony under 4 years of age may be ridden at the event.
9. No stallions
10. No cantering outside of warm up areas and arenas.
11. Please observe care in the parking area and follow instructions. Please leave the area tidy when you leave. **No skipping out please.**
12. The Secretary may require to see Horse Passports, so please have them available on the day
13. No Substitution permitted unless prior agreement of the Secretary
14. All children must have a parent or guardian present to be responsible for them at any Mortimer riding club events mounted or un-mounted.
