Riders under 8yrs old (over 3yrs old). Ponies under 12.2. Combinations may not compete in Class 2. Lead-rein attached to the nose band.  
Test can be found on MRC website.  
Points will be awarded for costume and count to overall score



**Class 2: Intro C (2016)**  
**Section A - Riders 8 to 12yrs**  
**Section B - Riders 12 years and over**

Points will be awarded for Easter Bonnet and count to overall score



**Class 3: Prelim 18 (2002)**

Points will be awarded for Easter Bonnet and count to overall score

# RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The Committee recommend that all riders have adequate Personal, Third Party and Horse Insurance
- Everyone mounted - whether a competitor or not - MUST wear protective headgear that includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and fastened at all times. A riding hat complying with BS6473 or a skull cap BS4472 is the compulsory minimum required, however British Riding Clubs recommend that the PAS015 standard or equivalent be worn. MRC recommends that a body protector meeting the latest standards be worn in jumping classes.
- The Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel the event or any of the published information
- In the event of an objection the Secretary's decision is final
- No refund of entry fees will be made except on receipt of a Doctors or Veterinary Surgeon's certificate
- No horse or pony under 4yo may be ridden at the event
- No stallions or dogs
- No cantering outside of the warm up areas and arenas
- Please observe care in the parking area and always follow any instructions give. Leave the area tidy when you leave and clear of horse droppings
- No skipping out
- No Lunging
- First Aid is 999 call only, so people ride at their own risk
- The Secretary may require to see Horse Passports, so please have them available on the day
- Please take care in the parking area and follow instructions if given. Leave the area tidy when you leave and clear of horse droppings
- All Children – mounted or not – are the responsibility of their Parent/Guardian at all times
- All mounted riders under 8yo must be accompanied by an adult in the ring, with the horse/pony on a lead rein
- Handlers must be 8yo or over, or are to be accompanied in the ring by an adult (18yo or over)
