RING 1

IN-HAND

All handlers to be 8 years or over as of 1st September 2021 or accompanied by an adult.

- CLASS 1** **Youngstock**
Open to all horses and ponies 4yo and under
- CLASS 2** **Condition and Turn Out**
Open to all horses and ponies, judged on 50% horse 50% handler.
Please state on entry form if horse is stabled or 24hr grass kept all year round
- CLASS 3** **British Native Small Breeds**
Open to all registered & unregistered British breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Section A&B)
- CLASS 4** **British Native Large Breeds**
Open to all registered & unregistered British Breeds (Welsh Section C&D, New Forest, Dales, Fell, Highland, Shire, TB Suffolk Punch)
- CLASS 5** **Non-British Native breed**
Open to all registered & unregistered non-British breeds (Arabs, Connemara, Fjord, Friesan, Irish Draft, etc)
- CLASS 6** **Coloured**
Open to all Skewbald, Piebald & Tri Coloured
- CLASS 7** **Odd Coloured**
Open to all Dun, Palomino, Roan, Spotted
- CLASS 8** **Solid Colour**
Open to all Chestnut, Black, Grey, Bay
- CLASS 9** **Veteran**
Open to all horses & ponies 15yo and over (passports may be checked)
- Class 10** **In-Hand Show Horse**
Open to all horses & ponies 14.3hh and over, must be plaited. Open to small, lightweight, medium, & heavyweight types
- CLASS 11** **Child's Pony**
Open to ponies 14.2hh and under.
Riders must have had their 3rd birthday by the show date and be no older than 10 years. Must be led by an adult (18yrs & over) with child present. Snaffle bridles only and lead reins to be attached to nosebands or chains. Not to be judged on conformation but on **manners and suitability** as a genuine child's pony.

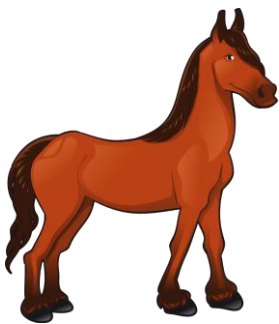

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectator's or any other person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The Committee recommend that all riders have adequate Personal, Third Party and Horse Insurance
- Everyone mounted - whether a competitor or not - MUST wear protective headgear that includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and fastened at all times. A riding hat complying with BS6473 or a skull cap BS4472 is the compulsory minimum required with BSI kite mark, however British Riding Clubs recommend that the PAS015 standard or equivalent be worn.
- The Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel the event or any of the published information
- In the event of an objection the Secretary's decision is final
- No refund of entry fees will be made except on receipt of a doctor's or Veterinary Surgeon's certificate
- No horse or pony under 4yo may be ridden at the event
- No stallions or dogs
- No cantering outside of the warm-up areas and arenas
- Please observe care in the parking area and always follow any instructions given. Leave the area tidy when you leave and clear of horse droppings
- No skipping out
- First Aid is 999 calls only, so people ride at their own risk
- The Secretary may require to see Horse Passports, so please have them available on the day
- All Children – mounted or not – are the responsibility of their Parent/Guardian at all times
- Handlers must be 8yo or over, or are to be accompanied in the ring by an adult (18yo or over)
