RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or
 their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage
 or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person whatsoever whether caused by
 their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The Committee recommend that all
 riders have adequate Personal, Third Party and Horse Insurance
- Everyone mounted whether a competitor or not MUST wear protective headgear that includes a
 permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points.
- Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and always fastened. Protective
 headgear complying with BS6473 and kite marked is the compulsory minimum required. However
 British Riding Clubs recommend that protective headgear approved to PAS015 2011 standard or
 equivalent be worn. Headgear approved to PAS 015 1998 or SNELL 2001 are no longer acceptable.
 MRC recommends that a body protector meeting the latest standards be worn in jumping classes.
- Competition clothes must be worn with appropriate footwear. No jeans or trainers.
- The Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel the event or any of the published information.
- No substitutions permitted unless with prior agreement of the Secretary.
- No refund of entry fees will be made except on receipt of a doctors or Veterinary Surgeon's certificate.
- In the event of an objection the Secretary's decision is final.
- The Secretary WILL require Horse Passports, so please have them available on the day.
- First Aid is 999/112 call only, so people ride at their own risk.
- You are responsible for your horse and its actions and must have your veterinary contact details with you.
- No horse or pony under 4 may be ridden at the event.
- No stallions or dogs.
- All Children mounted or not are **always** the responsibility of their Parent/Guardian.
- All mounted riders are to be 4yo or over at the time of the event.
- All handlers/riders under 8yo must be accompanied by an adult (18yo or over) in the ring, with the horse/pony on a lead rein where appropriate.
- No cantering except in the warmup areas and arenas. No lunging or long reigning.
- Please observe care in the parking area and always follow any instructions give.
- No skipping out. Leave the area tidy and PLEASE CLEAR YOUR HORSE DROPPINGS FROM AROUND YOUR TRAILER/LORRY BEFORE DEPARTING
