Clinics for flatwork, poles, show jumping and cross-country schooling over 3 days.

Non refundable deposit of £60 required (unless your place is filled) at time of booking and full settlement required by 9th May 2025

There are two cross country fields, a gridwork and pole arena, 1x 20x40 grass dressage arena and 1x 60x40 grass arena jump schools.

We will have full use of a kitchen and BBQ area, showers and a lounge with sofas for chilling in the evening. There are 15 stables and individual small grass turn out plus an additional 6 grass paddocks without stables. Stables are all prepared with straw, three of the stables have rubber mats if people want to provide their own shavings.

Your accommodation can be tents, caravans, lorries or trailers. There are loads of off road hacking for during your down time and lots of horse friendly pubs if participants wish for an evening out.

Catering – we will arrange a continental breakfast, cold buffet lunch and evening meals or a pub evening meal over 3 evenings. We could get in fish & chips on the first night when everyone settling in.

RULES & CONDITIONS OF CAMP

- 1. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators or any other person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The committee recommend that all riders have adequate personal, Third-Party Liability and horse insurance.
- Everyone mounted, whether a participant or not MUST wear protective headgear that includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and always fastened. A riding hat complying with BSEN1384 or EN1384 with PAS015 (1998 or 2011) or kite mark but not BSEN1384 on its own, is the compulsory minimum required. Please see www.bhs.org.uk for safety and for current requirements.
- 3. It is a requirement that a body protector to the latest standards is worn by all who are jumping and that medical arm bands are worn.
- 4. No refund of booking fees will be made except on receipt of a doctor's or veterinary surgeon's certificate or if your place can be filled.
- No horse or pony under 4 years of age may be ridden at the event.
- 6. No dogs or stallions.
- Please observe care in the parking area and follow instructions. Please leave the area tidy when you leave. No skipping out please.
- 8. First aid will be by 999/112 calls only. People attend at their own risk.
